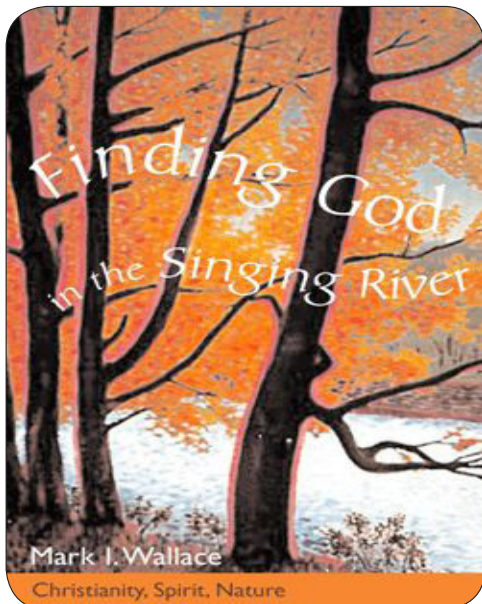
## THEOLOGIAN IN RESIDENCE LECTURE SERIES
