



Richard Shaull
Worldwide Ministries Award

Bryn Mawr Presbyterian Church

The award is designed to fund new mission undertakings and/or to provide support for remarkable mission leaders. It may be designated for salaries (of a project or a remarkable individual doing Kingdom work), buildings, sabbaticals, study, service programs, travel and other uses that promote the mission and ministry of Christ's Church in the world. The award is one-time grant.

Criteria shall include the following (criteria meant to be broadly interpreted and inclusive, not a rigid checklist):

- a. Justice or transformational ministry
- b. Sustainable
- c. Evangelical in the broadest sense
- d. Empowering
- e. Partnership rather than paternal
- f. Respectful of the culture(s) in which it operates
- g. Financially transparent and accountable

This award is designed to reflect the mission perspective of Richard (Dick) Shaull, former Presbyterian Missionary in Columbia and Brazil and Professor Emeritus at Princeton Theological Seminary. Dick worshipped and was a Parish Associate at Bryn Mawr Presbyterian Church during the final years of his life. He guided BMPC in re-tooling the mission program and helped craft new goals – such as those reflected in the criteria above – that are rooted in faith, justice and mutual respect.

Dick Shaull believed in the transformation of individuals and societies. His work in Liberation Theology and later Pentecostalism reflects the breadth of his experience and the originality of his thinking. The BMPC's Richard Shaull Worldwide Ministries Award is designed to reflect his witness to Jesus Christ and our joy during his time with us.
