Whether you are new to counseling or have seen counselors in the past, we are here to offer a welcoming setting where you can access quality, affordable counseling regardless of your background or current circumstances.

Tell Me About the Counselors

The Middleton Counseling Center contracts a variety of different counselors and spiritual directors. Each counselor has their own area(s) of expertise. You can read about each counselor on our website at middletoncenter.org

How do I connect with a counselor?

The best place to start is by calling us at 610-525-0766. We will ask you a few questions to better understand your needs and can recommend a counselor. After that we will have a counselor contact you directly.

Once connected with a counselor, you will establish a relationship and discuss the nature and scope of treatment, the therapeutic philosophy and your rights within the relationship. You can also ask your counselor any questions you have about their expertise, background, or experience. The frequency and content of counseling is a discussion to be had between you and your counselor.

Will my information be shared outside of the counseling relationship?

Absolutely not. Confidentiality is respected at all times. A signed consent form is needed for any information to be shared outside of a counseling appointment. Your counselor will not discuss the content of your appointment with Middleton Counseling Center staff members. The Middleton Counseling Center retains basic contact information as needed, but never shares your private information with any other organization.

Where do we meet?

The Middleton Counseling Center is housed on the campus of Bryn Mawr Presbyterian Church. The Center has its own space which is separate and distinct from the Church. Your counselor will direct you to your specific counseling room.

How much does counseling cost?

Each individual practitioner sets their own fee structures. Please inquire directly with your counselor to determine the fee amount.

What if I cannot afford counseling?

The Middleton Counseling Center believes quality counseling should be available to all people. All scholarship appointments cost \$105 per session. Scholarships are available based on your Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) as indicated on your recent tax form or two recent pay stubs. Scholarships are gifts given for your benefit and paid directly to your counselor.

Below is the chart that indicates the scholarship amount based on your AGI. In the chart the first number is the amount paid by the client, whereas the scholarship amount is listed in parenthesis:

How do I apply for a scholarship:

Complete these two steps:

- 1. Complete the Middleton Counseling Center Scholarship Form. You can obtain an application online at middletoncenter.org or from your counselor.
- 2. Provide a copy of the front page of your most recent tax filing which indicates their Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) OR provide a copy of your two most recent paycheck stubs.
